Setting Up A Multi-Site Connection

- 1. If not done so already, setup the individual sites in the Site Manager (Multi-Site connections can only be setup from sites launched from the site manager).
- 2. Launch the site you wise to use as part of a multi-site view from the Site Manager.
- 3. After the site loads right click on the camera you wish to include in the multi-site view. When the popup menu appears select 'Add To A Multo-Site'.
- 4. The dialog below will appear. If there are no site names in the list create one and click 'Add New Group'

- 5. Click on a site in the list and then click the select button.
- 6. A dialog will appear showing a list of cameras and sites already part of the group, with the newly added one at the top. Select OK to save and add the new camera or Cancel. You can also delete other cameras from the list by selecting the camera and clicking the Delete button.
